

The City Council met in special session on June 4, 2010 at 7:15 a.m. at the Council Rooms Sac City Municipal Building with the following members present: Bill Brenny, Jim Frederick, Nich Frohardt, Gary Hansen, Jim Johnston, with Barb Bloes, Mayor presiding.

The council resumed the discussion in regard to Steele, Inc.'s request for a contract amendment. FEMA has indicated to City Administrator Adam Ledford that they would approve a request for additional funding based on the information given for additional work performed by the contractor. It was moved by Bill Brenny and seconded by Jim Johnston to amend Steele, Inc.'s contract to include an additional 268 trees with the stipulation that they complete the cleanup work and the trees at the water plant and on Duffy Hill.

Roll call was taken and vote was as follows:
